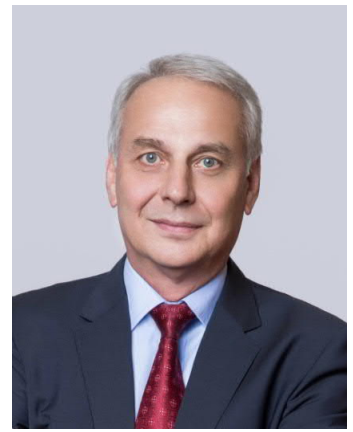


# Lothar Herrmann

Lothar Herrmann is Executive Vice President Siemens AG, President and CEO Siemens Greater China and Chairman, President and CEO Siemens Ltd., China.

Herrmann joined Siemens AG in 1991 as Manager for International Region and moving through various management positions in many areas including strategy, energy, industry, and in countries like Germany, Bangladesh, China, Thailand, Singapore, etc.

Herrmann has been associated with Siemens in China since 1995 when he assumed the position as Director of Corporate Strategy of Siemens China and Head of Siemens AG Task Force China in Beijing.

In 1999, he became Vice President Operations Northwest Europe of Siemens AG in Munich.

From 2001 to 2005, he was Siemens AG Vice President Sales New Plants & Services China and heading the Power Generation Group of Siemens China before assuming the position as President and CEO of Siemens Thailand and CEO of Siemens ASEAN Region.

In February 2009, he was appointed as President and CEO of Siemens Singapore, responsible for the ASEAN-Pacific Region. In addition, from 2008 to 2013, he was responsible for the industrial business in ASEAN and later the ASEAN-Pacific Region.

From November 2013 to March 2019, he was CEO Siemens Greater China and President and CEO of Siemens Ltd., China.

Besides his responsibilities in Siemens, Herrmann took leadership positions in various organizations. He was member of the Singapore Economic Development Board of Directors (2011-2015) and member of the Singapore National Research Foundation (2011-2013). He was appointed by the government of Singapore as Co-Chairman of Singapore's Economic Strategies Committee in year 2009/2010.

Within the network of the German Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Herrmann served as President and Board Member in Thailand and Singapore, and as Chairman of German Chamber of Commerce in Beijing.

He was the Chairman of Executive Committee of Foreign Investment Companies China (2014-2016).

He was awarded the "White Magnolia Award" by the Shanghai Municipal Government in 2016. In 2017, Herrmann was appointed as Advisory Professor of Tsinghua University in Beijing.
