Welcome!

This leaflet is intended to familiarize you with the safety rules at Rail Service Center in Munich-Allach. Please take a few minutes to read the important safety instructions.

Always observe the instructions given by the person accompanying you or any other Siemens personnel. The bringing of unauthorized hazardous substances is prohibited. External companies and service providers need to register with the responsible coordinator for external companies before the start of the work.

Access to the site

The site can only be accessed Monday to Friday from 6:45 AM to 7:30 PM via the entrance gate. Please sign in at the entrance gate where you will receive your visitor's pass. Wait here to be picked up by your company contact.

Visitors are not allowed to stay overnight at the test center. Please report any items that are found, lost or stolen to the entrance gate immediately.

Travel by car

Please park your car in the visitor parking area outside the entrance gate.

An access pass may be obtained at the entrance gate in exceptional cases. The German Road Traffic Act (StVO) applies throughout the premises, please observe the following special rules:

- Maximum speed 20 km/h
- Right has-right-of-way
- Vehicles parked contrary to traffic regulations will be towed at the owner's expense
- Rail vehicles always have priority!
- Keep clear of rails, minimum distance 1.5 m from outer edge of rail

Key safety instructions



Standing under suspended loads is prohibited.



Jumping over work pits is prohibited.



Train movements and shunting can always take place in the track area. These will always have priority. Keep a safety distance of 2 m from stationary rail vehicles.



Open (high) voltages can be present in designated areas.



It is prohibited to leave marked routes and passages without safety footwear.



Please enter halls always through personnel entry doors, not rolling gates.



Cycling inside the buildings is prohibited.



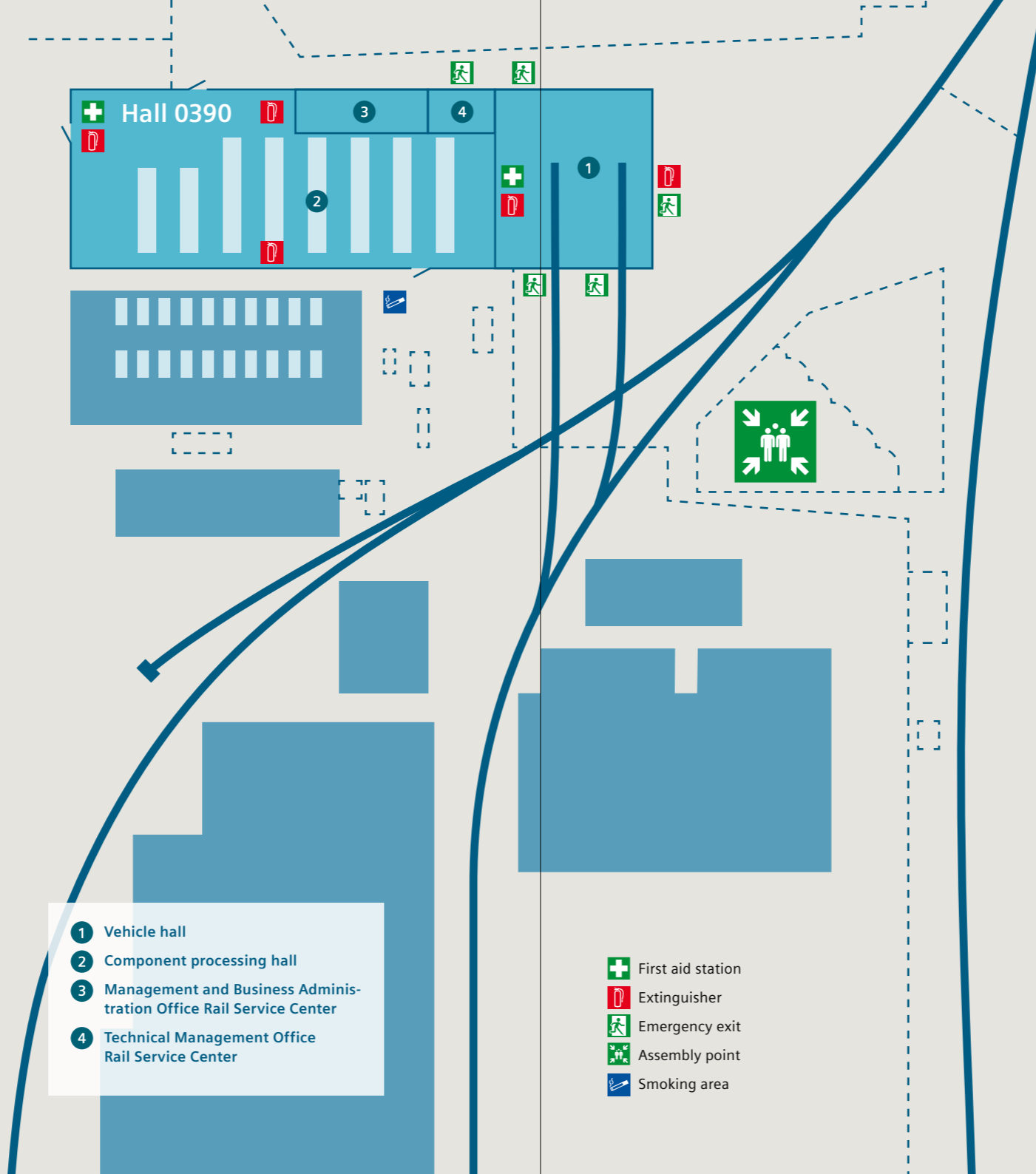
Photography and filming are only allowed with permission.



Smoking in the workshops, buildings and vehicles is prohibited. Smoking is only permitted in designated smoking areas.



Alcohol is strictly prohibited on the entire site.

Clothing regulations



A warning vest/jacket must be worn in the area of the test track. Access with special permission only.



Safety shoes must be worn in the buildings and in the test track area (does not apply to visitor groups).



Protective headgear must be worn under vehicles and in work pits.



Hearing protection must be worn in noise areas ≥ 85 dB(A).



Protective goggles must be worn in areas where damage to eyes can occur.
