Jobs boost as C R Reynolds paves way for Goole facility

An East Yorkshire construction company has employed six new people as a direct result of working on Siemens Mobility's project in Goole.

Hessle-based C R Reynolds Ltd has been contracted to carry out enabling works on the site of the industry-leading rail manufacturing facility and this has meant a trainee site manager, two groundworkers, a gateman, an apprentice and a cleaner have all been taken on.



The company has built hardstanding for temporary offices, created car parking for project team members, built a temporary road for access and installed security fencing on the site.

The C R Reynolds team are now preparing to create entrances and exits on the site from the main highway, carry out related highways and drainage works, and install lighting and security measures, paving the way for construction of the trains factory and associated facilities.

C R Reynolds worked throughout the lockdown period, with strict Covid-19 safety measures and social distancing in place, so that such an important project could continue to move forward.

Managing Director of C R Reynolds, Andy Gaze, said: "We're really happy to be part of this major project

and it has enabled us to grow our own team at the same time.

"We have kept trading, haven't had to furlough anyone and have taken on six new people for the Siemens works, which has been fantastic.

"This is such a positive investment and a major boost for the region, particularly from a job creation perspective.

"It was also great to see Prime Minister Boris Johnson visit the site in July and that was a big morale boost for our team during the pandemic.

"His interest shows how much this means nationally, as well as within the region, and it lifted the profile of the project."
