Status of the Second Funding Round

24 projects from more than 20 countries were selected for funding in the Second Round of the Siemens Integrity Initiative and will receive funding of up to US\$ 35,554 million.

Funding applications were received from more than 180 well-known non-profit organizations from about 60 countries.

Below you find a list of First Funding Round projects:

Al Akhawayn University

The main objective of this project is to enhance integrity in the Moroccan business environment through the creation of a center for business ethics.
