Expansion of manufacturing facilities in Burlington, Ontario and Peterborough, Ontario allowed Siemens Canada to increase production of sustainable Printed Circuit Board Assemblies, as well as solar inverters for the Canadian solar photovoltaic market. In addition, Siemens' first Canadian wind turbine blade manufacturing plant in Tillsonburg, Ontario went into commercial operation in 2011.

Other highlights of the Siemens Canada Sustainability Report 2011 include the continuing designation of the company as one of Canada's Top 100 Employers for the third consecutive year, as well as being recognized as one of Canada's 50 Most Engaged Workplaces.

"Siemens Canada's commitment to sustainability is reflected in both our short-term and long-term strategies," said Hardt. "Our achievements are based on our employee's belief in the principles of sustainability in all aspects of our corporate activities."
