



# Lothar Herrmann

**CEO Siemens Greater China  
President and CEO Siemens Ltd., China**

Lothar Herrmann is CEO Siemens Greater China, and President and CEO of Siemens Ltd., China since November 2013.

Herrmann has been associated with Siemens in China since 1995 when he assumed the position as Director of Corporate Strategy of Siemens Ltd., China and Head of Siemens AG Task Force China in Beijing. From 2001 to 2005 he was Siemens AG Vice President Sales New Plants & Services China and heading the Power Generation Group of Siemens China before assuming the position as President and CEO of Siemens Thailand and CEO of Siemens ASEAN.

Before taking his current position, he was President and CEO of Siemens Pte Ltd. Singapore since February 2009, responsible for the ASEAN-Pacific Region.

Herrmann joined Siemens AG in 1991, starting as Manager for International Region Asia and moving through various management positions obtaining expertise in many areas including strategy, energy, industry, and leading operations in countries like Germany, Bangladesh, China, Thailand, Singapore, etc.

Besides his responsibilities in Siemens, Herrmann took leadership positions in various organizations to promote cross-border mutual understanding and exchange. He was member of the Singapore Economic Development Board of Directors (2011-2015), a member of the Singapore National Research Foundation, Energy Research, Development & Demonstration Executive Committee (2011-2013). He was appointed by the government of Singapore as Co-Chairman of Singapore's Economic Strategies Committee (2009/2010).

He was the Chairman of Executive Committee of Foreign Investment Companies China (2014-2016).

Within the network of the German Chamber of Commerce and Industry Herrmann served as President and Board Member in Thailand, Singapore and currently as Chairman of the German Chamber North China.

Herrmann is Member of the International Advisory Councils for the Mayor of Wuhan and the Mayor of Jinan. He serves as a Member of the Board of Trustees of the Tongji University of Shanghai.

In recognition of his contribution to promoting social and economic development of Shanghai, he was awarded the "White Magnolia Award" by the Shanghai Municipal Government in 2016. In 2017 Herrmann was appointed as Advisory Professor of Tsinghua University in Beijing.
