Safety is Mobility competitive advantage. It is what sets us apart and it is our main identifying feature.


The Management of Mobility has established this Safety Policy to cover aspects such as fundamental responsibility for the safety of developments and changes, configurations, systems and products, and the continuity of the business, which is transmitted to the rest of the organisational structure by the managers, area managers and project managers.

Mobility division Safety Policy ensures that the train signalling, control and protection systems and products that it designs, manufactures, installs, modifies or maintains comply with established safety requirements and with the European safety regulations, according its applicability, that apply to our sector of activity (EN 50126, EN 50128 and EN 50129).

Mobility shall make every effort to comply with that set out above

- by applying knowledge acquired through extensive experience
- by employing demanding organisational and operational standards aimed at systematically and pro-actively ensuring that all safety-related targets are impeccably met
- by methodologically reviewing the performance of the different processes in order to identify and apply better practices

The motivation of all personnel is essential to achieve this. For the purpose of providing proper support so that all personnel participating in activities throughout the life-cycle of a system, from its bidding phase, developing, until its withdrawal from service, are aware of their responsibility in this area, the leaders of Mobility shall be delegated by this Management to ensure adequate motivation concerning the safety of its employees.
