### Today's Investment:

- Initial \$220 million investment
- 200-acre plant will turn brownfield into an advanced rail manufacturing facility
- More than 500 new jobs will be created, becoming one of the city's largest employers
- Over the course of the 12-year term of this grant, the project is estimated to grow the state's economy by \$1.6 billion

### Tomorrow's Infrastructure:

- Production to begin in 2024
- Planned manufacturing of Venture coaches, one of the most popular passenger coach platforms in the North American market
- First of its kind offering in North America for Customer Services with coach and locomotive overhauls – an offering we do not currently provide
- The facility will be carbon neutral, enhancing the company's current commitment to be carbon neutral by 2030

### Building on Strong History:

- Siemens Mobility has been building and servicing trains in the U.S. for 40+ years
- Our manufacturing facility at our Rolling Stock headquarters in Sacramento, California has grown from 800 workers in 2015 to employ more than 2,500 workers today
- More than 3,000 trains have been manufactured by Siemens Mobility in the U.S.
- One in three Light Rail Vehicles in the U.S. are Siemens Mobility LRVs
- More than 2,000 suppliers across the U.S., including more than 40 in the state of North Carolina representing more than \$42 million in investments in FY22
