

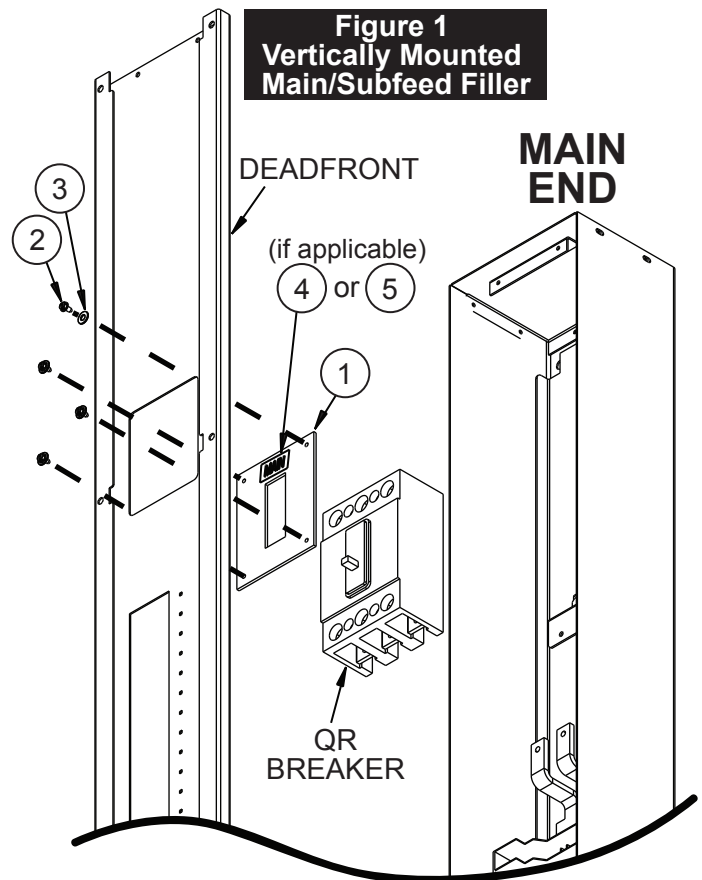

C1 Filler Kit for QR Breaker Installation Instructions

This instruction sheet is for the MBKQRC1FK filler kit for a vertically-mounted 225A MAX QR2 breaker (limited to 10kA interrupt rating). This will work on column panelboards, both single or three-phase, in the MAIN or SUBFEED location.

1. Lock off all power supplying this equipment before working on it.
2. Remove the panelboard front cover and deadfront.
3. Remove the old filler and dispose of properly.
4. Carefully remove the breaker.
5. Inspect this area and ensure the mounting bracket and connectors are in good shape and secure.
6. Follow the new QR breaker installation instructions.
7. Install the C1 QR deadfront plate (provided in this kit) onto the deadfront by first positioning it behind the deadfront and then using the supplied screws and washers to draw it against the back of the deadfront (as shown in Figure 1).
8. This kit includes two labels: one marked **MAIN** and the other marked **SERVICE DISCONNECT**. For main breaker applications, apply the **MAIN** label (as shown). For service entrance panels, apply the **SERVICE DISCONNECT** label instead. Dispose of any labels that are not used.
9. **Before energizing the panel**, ensure that ALL connections have been properly torqued, that the deadfront is installed and that all fillers are in place.
