Key projects _

In 2000 COIMA launched an urban regeneration project for Milan's district, Porta Nuova. The re-convented business district includes two of the most recognizable visual landmarks – the building Gioia 22 as well as the multi-tenant asset Pirelli 35. In 2022 Porta Nuova was the first district in the world that received both of the industry's most well-known certifications – LEED and WELL for Communities.

Key technology provided by Siemens _

Results

Both buildings are equipped to meet Europe's 2030 net zero goals.
