A Next Generation Investment

- In July of 2021, Siemens Mobility was awarded \$3.4 billion in contracts to design, manufacture, and technically support 73 Amtrak Airo trainsets.
- In August of 2023, 10 additional trainsets were ordered bringing the total order number to 83 trainsets.
- The first trainset is scheduled to be delivered in 2024 with operation scheduled to start in 2026.
- The new trains will operate on routes throughout the country.
- The procurement of these trainsets is supported by funding from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA).

A Robust Supply Chain

- 96 U.S. suppliers providing 3,829 individual project parts
- 16 California suppliers providing 2,141 of those individual project parts
- 11 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE)/ Small Business Enterprise (SBE) suppliers

An American Workforce

- These trainsets have started production at Siemens Mobility's 60-acre solar-powered North American rail headquarters in Sacramento, California.
- Siemens Mobility has nearly 4,500 employees across North America.
- With full manufacturing capabilities including design, engineering, testing, carshell, bogies, subassembly, and final assembly, the facility has manufactured more than 3,000 vehicles for 35 transit agencies in the U.S. and Canada.
