

Terms and Conditions for the Competition

By participating in the Competition, you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions (Terms). If an entrant (you) does not accept these Terms, you must not participate in the Competition and will not be eligible for any prizes offered in the Competition.

Promoter: Siemens Ltd (ABN 98 004 347 880)

Background: The Promoter is planning monthly competitions as part of its overall Beyond 150 Competition.

Competition: Beyond 150 Competition – New Zealand Technology Tour

Eligible Entrants: The Competition is open to entrants residing in Australia and New Zealand only who are 18 years of age or older at the time of entry submission. Directors or employees of any Siemens affiliated companies and their immediate family members are not eligible to participate.

Maximum number of entries: Only one entry is allowed per person in the competition. Multiple entries from the same person (including with different email addresses or usernames) are not permitted.

Competition: Start 3 September 2026 and close 31 October 2026.

The Promoter may, in its sole discretion, make any updates or changes to the competition dates at any time.

Entry Method

The Competition is a game of skill. To enter the Competition, you must:

- complete questions within the competition section(s) and submit the entry; and
- provide your full name and contact details.

The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any late, lost or misdirected entries due to technical disruptions, network congestion or issues, or for any other reason.

Notification of winners: The winner will be contacted via email and / or phone by the Promoter, using the contact details provided on entry. The name of the winner will be published on the Competition entry website.

Claim Period: Winners will be contacted via phone and email by a representative from Globetrotter/The Incentive Lab in late January 2027. The winner will have three weeks from contact to claim the Prize. If the winner does not claim the Prize by this date, the winner will forfeit the Prize. The prize allocation is for one winner and a guest above 18 years of age.

Unclaimed Prize: If the winner does not claim the prize within the Claim Period, the Promoter reserves its rights at its sole discretion to select the entrant with the next highest ranked entry as the winner or retain the unclaimed prize. Where the Promoter elects a replacement winner, the next person contacted will have three weeks from date the Promoter sent the email to the replacement winner, to claim the Prize.

General Terms and Conditions

- The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these conditions or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the competition.
- Prizes will be specified by the Promoter and no substitutes or changes will be allowable.
- The prize and dates are subject to flights, hotel and event tickets availability at the time of request and are subject to the specific Prize terms and conditions set out below.
- Prizes must be taken within the period specified in the Prize terms and conditions and will otherwise be forfeited. If a Prize is not taken within such period, the Promoter may, at its sole discretion, re-distribute or retain the Prize.
