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Introduction

These documents were created for all our customers and Siemens engineers, which are involved in engineering and/or commissioning of IEC61850 Ethernet networks in substations. Because of more and more requests regarding how to setup and design IEC61850 Ethernet networks, the product management of the energy automation department decided to publish some design recommendations and to provide predefined configuration files of the Ruggedcom switches. In that way the IEC61850 projects all over the world will be more similar and the commissioning phase will speed up.

How to work with the documents

Use the document “**Overall workflow**” to have a thread through the complete setup-phase of the communication network.

Several designs are recommended. For every design there is a network sketch available document “**Network Sketch Design xx**”. In that sketch you see how to connect the devices together, also at which ports.

The dedicated document “**Description Design xx**” describes the design more in detail.

The xls-files “**design xx RSG2100 switch yyy.csv**”, which are dedicated to the designs contain the necessary configuration data for the Ruggedcom switches.

The files can be uploaded directly to the Ruggedcom switches with the Ruggedcom file transfer utility. “**RC-TFTP-1.16.1**”.
