Siemens AG (Berlin and Munich) is a global technology powerhouse that has stood for engineering excellence, innovation, quality, reliability and internationality for 174 years. The company brings together the digital and physical worlds to benefit customers and society, focusing on intelligent infrastructure for buildings and decentralized energy systems, on automation and digitalization in the process and manufacturing industries, and on smart mobility solutions for rail and road transport. In fiscal 2020, the Siemens Group generated revenue of  $\notin$ 57.1 billion and net income of  $\notin$ 4.2 billion. As of September 30, 2020, the company had around 293,000 employees worldwide.

Innovations have always formed the basis for Siemens' success. In fiscal year 2020, the company filed about 2,740 patents and submitted around 5,120 invention disclosure reports. In total, Siemens holds 42,900 issued patents – an equivalent of 23 inventions every working day. The company employs around 40,700 R&D employees worldwide and reports an R&D expenditure of €4.6 billion in fiscal 2020. All of these figures include Siemens Healthineers and exclude Siemens Energy.
