

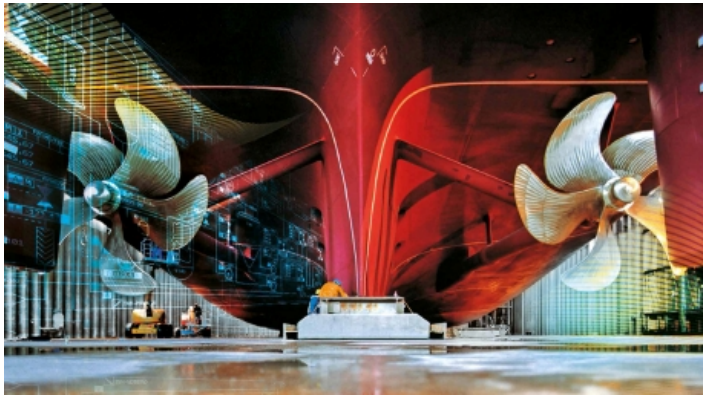
> Siemens at Pacific 2015

Examples of these technologies will also be present to see and experience first-hand. What could superconductivity mean to the future of Australia’s defence capability? A special announcement will be made at the Siemens stand on Tuesday, 6 October.

Siemens submarine technology, which propels a majority of conventional submarines today, will be present including PEM Fuel Cell and Permasyn propulsion motor, to demonstrate the capability edge they provide navies today.

The Royal New Zealand Navy will also be at the Siemens stand demonstrating a fully operational version of the new ship control system installed last year on their ANZAC Class frigates.

Global technology experts will be available to discuss how the latest Siemens technologies are providing design, power, propulsion, PLM, control and through-life support solutions for navies all around the world.
