Decarbonizing cities with smart buildings, electric mobility, distributed power systems and grid optimization.

- The company located in Portugal an electric mobility ecosystem, which includes production capacity, research and development, and a competence center for sales, engineering, project management and servicing. Most of the production of DC fast chargers from Corroios factory is exported and the plan is to significantly increase quantities in the next 3 years.
- Siemens is technological partner of reference hospitals, pharma and life science institutions private and public. The most recent one was Botton-Champalimaud Pancreatic Center, in Lisbon, the first research and treatment center for pancreatic cancer in the world;
- In the Energy Distribution field, Siemens is the leading supplier of Protection & Control Systems for Utilities and Renewables and supplied over 1 million smart meters which are installed in Portuguese homes.

Transforming industries

Supporting the Portuguese industry on its digitalization and sustainability journey.

- The Cranes Engineering Hub, licensed to operate in the EMEA area, has already modernized around 100 gantries in ten countries.
- The Intralogistics Hub team carries out international projects related to control and management systems for automated warehouses;
- The company installed a real-time location system for mobile asset management at VW Autoeuropa, the production unit Volkswagen has in Portugal, which is the main national exporter.

Siemens is promoting an **experimentation and collaboration ecosystem** by opening dedicated experimentation and co creation spaces, namely, Industry 4.0 Experiment Centers in Alfragide and Porto focusing digitalization of industries. On top, Academies were located in relevant Portuguese universities. To cover the topics from Smart Infrastructure, a Grid Edge Lab was set up and also a Smart building & Cyber Security Lab.

- Siemens Mobility recently won a contract to modernize and upgrade the Lisbon Metro. The company will install its Communications-Based Train Control (CBTC) system Trainguard MT across three lines, and will upgrade the existing equipment, including the installation of its on-board CBTC technology across 70 trains of the existing fleet, as well as on 14 new trains supplied by the consortium partner, Stadler. Siemens is also supplying training, preventive, and corrective maintenance.
- Siemens Mobility set up an **Intermodal Solutions Competence Center in Aveiro.** The Software Development center is specialized in planning and information systems for public transport and ticketing solutions. The team consists of highly qualified profiles linked to information systems engineering and is constantly growing, currently employing around 60 people.

The company provided more than 62,500 training hours to its employees**. KPIs for digital training doubled to 16 hours per year, per employee - a number expected to be largely surpassed by the end of the fiscal year.
