### What do we offer?

Apprenticeships are a great way for us to turn today's talented people, like you, into the experts we need tomorrow. Whether you're interested in Engineering, Business or Finance, we have opportunities here and now for you.

#### Level 3 Apprenticeships:

Our level 3 apprenticeships take between three and four years to complete and work alongside your studies at a local college. Your first year will be spent studying full time, before joining us for hands-on training. You'll gain a Level 3, plus a technical engineering qualification (if relevant).

Students looking to do a Level 3 apprenticeship should have, or be expecting, a minimum of four GCSEs (or equivalent) at grade 4 or above including Maths and English.

#### Level 4 and 5 Apprenticeships:

Our Level 4 & 5 apprenticeships take between two and four years to complete and combine studying with hands-on training while you gain a Level 4 and a relevant HNC.

Students looking to do Level 4 or 5 degree apprenticeships should have a BTEC National Certificate / A Levels in a relevant discipline.

#### Degree Apprenticeships (Level 6 and 7):

Our degree apprenticeships take around three to five years to complete, and you can earn a Level 6-7 qualification, equivalent to a bachelor's or master's degree.

Students looking to do higher or degree apprenticeships should have a BTEC National Certificate / A Levels in a relevant discipline/s.

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## Application Process

### 1. Application screening

Your journey starts with your application.

However, we won't review your CV at this stage, as we believe skills can be developed and potential can be nurtured.

We are not so focused on what you have done - we care most about who you are and what potential you can bring.

### 2. Online behavioural based assessment

Provided you meet our minimal requirements, you will be invited to complete an online assessment.

This inclusive approach allows us to assess if you align with our core values and demonstrate the potential we're looking for.

This gives all candidates a fair chance regardless of their background.

### 3. On-Demand Video Interview

You may be asked to complete an on-demand video interview where you'll record yourself answering some pre-defined questions.

### 4. Assessment Centre/Interview

The final stage is an in-person assessment centre or interview; designed to get to know you more and introduce you to Siemens.
