Professional career

Dr. Wolfgang Heuring studied Physics at the University of Würzburg under Professor Gottfried Landwehr and completed his doctorate in 1990. Upon graduation, he joined Siemens AG as Team Leader for Test Automation in the Corporate Production & Logistics department. Starting in 1993, he worked at the corporate headquarters at Wittelsbacherplatz in Munich as a management consultant for the Productivity Center. In 1995, he transferred to the Automation & Drives Business Unit, first working as project manager for a global business reengineering project and, starting in 1997, as head of Research and Development for Standard Motors with development sites in Germany, the Czech Republic, and Mexico.

In 1999, Dr. Heuring took over as head of European Production for the Postal Automation Business Unit in Konstanz, Germany. In 2001, he was appointed global manager of the Sorting Machines subdivision. In 2004, Dr. Heuring became head of the Distribution & Industry Business Unit in Offenbach.

In 2006, he was named CEO of the Infrastructure & Cities Sector's Medium Voltage Business Unit in Erlangen.

In April 2012, Siemens AG's Managing Board named Dr. Heuring head of the global Research and Technology Center and head of Corporate Technology Regions.

Effective March 1, 2015 Wolfgang Heuring has been appointed Business Unit CEO Motion Control within the Siemens-Division Digital Factory.

Since April 01, 2019 Dr. Wolfgang Heuring is the CEO of the Business Unit Motion Control of Siemens Digital Industries.
