Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with Siemens for a 12-month period.
- Familiarize yourself with Siemens' global materials and methodologies, with a special focus on a similar project completed in Sweden. This includes access to materials and mentoring from teams in Estonia, Finland, and Sweden.

Contacts will be provided by the Siemens team in Estonia and the region.
- Participate in and co-facilitate discussion forums.
- Create research in cooperation with a university, supervised and mentored by Siemens, to identify drivers and highlight likely development scenarios for sustainable development in Estonia by 2035.

Requirements:

- Genuine passion for sustainable development.
- Excellent communication skills in English and Estonian; proficiency in Russian is an advantage.
- Relevant educational background in the fields such as environmental science, engineering, economics, or social sciences.
- Willingness to engage in networking with stakeholders in Estonia – meeting may take place at stakeholder locations or Siemens office in Tallinn.
- Strong analytical skills and the ability to develop insightful hypotheses.
- Ability to conduct effective stakeholder interviews and engage in meaningful discussions.
- Prior research experience is an advantage but not mandatory.
