### Corporate Knights releases latest rankings in Davos, Switzerland

Siemens AG has been named as one of the globe's most sustainable corporations by Toronto-based Corporate Knights. The media and investment advisory company today released the 2014 iteration of its widely-followed Global 100 Most Sustainable Corporations in the World (Global 100) index at the World Economic Forum in Davos, Switzerland. Siemens secured the 27th position in the 2014 rankings, up from the 31st position in 2013.

Companies named to the Global 100 are the top overall sustainability performers in their respective industrial sectors. Inclusion in the index is determined using twelve (12) quantitative sustainability indicators, including the amount of revenue companies generate per unit of energy consumption, the ratio of CEO to average worker salary and lost time injury rate
