Beacon Rail orders 10 Vectron locomotives from Siemens Mobility

- Delivery of 10 Vectron MS multi-system locomotives
- From the Dutch North Sea to the Mediterranean without changing locomotives

Beacon Rail, a rolling stock leasing company, has ordered 10 Vectron MS multisystem locomotives from Siemens Mobility. Beacon Rail plans to have the locomotives operate along the Rhine-Alpine corridor and between the North Sea ports and the European hinterland. This order will give Beacon Rail an overall portfolio of 170 Vectron locomotives.

With the ordered Vectron MS, cross-border operations are possible in ten different European countries. "Beacon Rail is delighted that, following its recent acquisition of Mitsui Rail Capital Europe, it has ordered 10 additional Vectron locomotives to support the company's commitment to the European 4-axle electric rail freight and passenger markets. Beacon looks forward to further enhancing its relationship with Siemens Mobility," said Adam Cunliffe, CEO Beacon Rail.

The ordered multi-system locomotives have a maximum power at wheel of 6.4 megawatts and a top speed of 160 km/h. The locomotives will be manufactured at the Siemens Mobility plant in Munich-Allach. They are equipped with the European

To date, Siemens Mobility has sold more than 1,850 Vectron locomotives and the fleet has covered over 800 million kilometers. The Vectron is approved for operation in 20 European countries.
