

## Our history in Israel

From the first independent commercial representative to a global technology powerhouse

---

### **1921–1924**

Under the Palestine administration the Siemens-Schuckertwerke (SSW) conclude an agency agreement with The Palestine Company Hiram Ltd., Haifa

### **1926**

Siemens Orient S.A. Cairo opens a sub-office in Jaffa, Israel

### **1939**

Siemens Orient S.A. dissolves its sub-office in Jaffa and assigns representation of its interests in the Palestine Region to Wagner Bros. in Jaffa

### **1965**

The companies Inverko and Eisenberg Bros Ltd., both in Tel Aviv, are appointed to represent Siemens & Halske (S&H) respectively SSW in Israel

### **1972–1994**

The various Siemens business units are represented by numerous agents, e.g. Kornberg Bros Ltd., I. Ziegler / M. Sharon & Co. Ltd., Transelectro Company Ltd. and I. Ziegler Electrical Engineering Co.

### **1994**

Opening of a Siemens representative office in Israel

### **1994**

Siemens and the Israeli NISKO-ARDAN Group found the joint venture Communication IC Design Center Ltd.

### **1995**

Siemens Ltd., Israel, is established in Tel Aviv as a sales support holding

### **1995**

Siemens acquires Israeli high-tech company Ornet in Carmiel, which is renamed in Siemens Data Communications Ltd.

### **1996**

State power utility Israel Electric Corp. (IEC) in Haifa places an order with Siemens for power system control and protection equipment for the Tel Aviv and Haifa conurbations network

### **1997**

Siemens and the Israeli Orckit Communications Ltd. cooperate in the area of VDSL technology which enables interactive multimedia services via normal telephone lines

## **Our history in Israel**

### **2000**

Establishment of the newly-found Siemens Israel Ltd. as a Regional Company headquartered in Rosh Ha'ayin

### **2001**

IEC awards Siemens with the delivery of core components for three 360-MW combined cycle power plants (Haifa, Hagit and Gezer)

### **2006**

Israeli Railways places its first order for 87 passenger coaches which includes an option for another 585 cars

### **2007**

Siemens acquires UGS and its Technomatics branch in Israel which is renamed in Siemens Industry Software and operates in AirPort City

### **2008**

Siemens receives another order from IEC for the supply of components for three gas turbine power plants

### **2009**

Siemens acquires Israeli solar company Solel Solar Systems Ltd.

### **2010**

German President Wulff visits Siemens solar receiver production plant in Bet Shemesh near Jerusalem

### **2011**

Siemens delivers innovative traffic management system to Tel Aviv

### **2014**

Siemens signs a contract with Assuta Medical Center to deliver and install the first PET/MRI in Israel

### **2014**

Delivery of two gas turbines and one steam turbine for the 140-MW Soreq power plant which will supply electricity to the largest desalination plant in the world
