

Our history in Greece

From the first independent commercial representative to a global technology powerhouse

1900

Signing of a general representative agreement with the Greek firm Zachariou & Co.

1926

Founding of Griechische Telefon AG with Siemens & Halske (S&H) holding a 75 percent stake

1935

Founding of the Eviop Tempo AG, Electrical Equipment Manufacturer Aegaleo, with a majority stake held by Siemens

1939

Founding of the Siemens Hellenische Elektrotechnische AG, Elektrotechnische Projekte und Erzeugnisse

1952

Major order for equipping 12 metro trainsets for the subway line linking Piraeus and Athens

1964

Founding of the Siemens Tele Industry S.A.

1971

Contract between the state utility DEI and a German-Greek Siemens consortium for the supply and installation of six transformer stations in Athens and Saloniki

1982

Siemens Hellas Elektrotechnische AG is renamed Siemens AG Elektrotechnische Projekte und Erzeugnisse

1983

A pilot photovoltaic system is commissioned on the island of Kythnos in the Cyclades

1990

Siemens Tele Industrie AG, Thessaloniki, wins an order from the Greek telephone company OTE to supply 13 digital central and transit offices and two container digital electronic switching systems

1998

Siemens Metering S.A. (formerly Landis & Gyr) in Korinth becomes a wholly-owned subsidiary of Siemens S.A.

2000

Founding of offices in Macedonia and Cyprus

2004

All Siemens Groups successfully participate in numerous key projects for the Summer Olympic Games in Athens

2007

Siemens secures an order to provide the entire electromechanical infrastructure and security systems for the new Acropolis Museum

2010

Siemens actively supports Greek scientific community to continue research, despite the adverse economic circumstances

2012

Siemens signs a contract with Attiko Metro for the signaling extension for seven new stations to be added to the two existing metro lines serving the extended Athens metropolitan area

2013

Siemens announces the launch of 'Siemens – IKY (State Scholarships Foundation) Fellowships of Excellence Postgraduate Studies' program
