From the first business contacts to a global technology powerhouse

1958

Terms of payment for deliveries are agreed upon with the company Ahmed Sayid Hashim Al-Gharabally, representative agent in Bahrain

1969

A. A. Zayani & Sons is authorized to represent the interests of Siemens in Bahrain

1975

Siemens Medical Engineering signs an agency agreement with Modern Pharmaceutical Company for all of the United Arab Emirates; the agreement is transferred to Scientech in 1978

1977

Bahrain Markets in Manama is authorized as the agent representing the interests of Siemens AG in Bahrain

1977

The foreign agencies in Bahrain, Oman, Qatar and Yemen are overseen by Siemens' office in Dubai

1977

Siemens wins an order to supply a frequency converter for a dry dock for Bahrain-based Arab Shipbuilding and Repair Yard (ASRY)

1978

Siemens constructs a gas turbine power plant in Riffa, near the capital Manama, for the Ministry of Works, Power and Water in a record time of only 15 months; the plant is expanded in 1979 and 1980

1980

The agency rights for Siemens are transferred from Bahrain Market to Transitec Gulf

1991

Electrical engineering equipment is supplied for the international airport in Bahrain

1999

The Siemens Limited Liability Company (L.L.C.) established in Abu Dhabi and Dubai also engages in business activities in Bahrain, Yemen, Oman and Qatar; it coordinates and supervises the agencies in the region

2003

The Bahraini company Cebarco-WCT W.L.L. awards Siemens a contract to supply, install and commission the technical infrastructure for the Formula 1 racetrack in Bahrain

2003

MTC Vodafone commissions Siemens to construct the first UMTS mobile radio network in the Middle East in Bahrain

2004

Siemens establishes a new Regional Company in Bahrain, Siemens W.L.L.

2005

Siemens builds a turnkey combined cycle power plant for Al Ezzel Power Company

2005

The Bahrain Defence Forces Hospital awards Siemens a contract to supply the region's first biplanar catheter laboratory

2008

Bahrain International Airport is equipped with a baggage handling system from Siemens

2011

Siemens W.L.L. in Bahrain launches a Service Center for Metallurgical Services for the Middle East's steel and aluminum industry, based at the Bahrain International Investment Park in Salman International City
